**Task: Strategic Plan: July, 2005-June 2007**

❖ **Stakeholder Analysis: October-January 2006**

*status—municipal survey and general public survey underway—complete*

❖ **SWOT Analysis: January-May 2006**

*Status—could use volunteers to help with SWOT*



❖ **DRAFT preliminary plan outline and GIS map: Nov-July 2006**

*Status—have an outline and a volunteer drafting plan—*

❖ **Presentation Materials research and development: August - March 2006**

*Status—complete.*

❖ **Nine Education Sessions( 6 in PV and 3 in Franklin): April-June 2006**

*Status—some sessions held and others planned. Could use a lot of help planning and organizing these sessions—identifying sites that are free, soliciting donations of food and drinks for participants, helping recruit speakers, on-site logistics, facilitation, ideas for site visits, publicity and outreach*

❖ **Outreach Sessions-round one (4 in PV, 2 in Franklin) to prepare goals and objectives and PV portion of RPS: September-October 2006**

*Status—pending—but will need same logistic support as for education sessions*

❖ **Draft Strategic Plan: August-December 2006**

*Status—outline prepared—could use assistance researching resources and documenting success stories/case studies—taking pictures, interviewing people and writing them*

❖ **Subtask 2i. Outreach Sessions to present DRAFT plan (2 in PV, 1 in Franklin): January-February 2007**

*Status—pending—but will need same logistic support as for education sessions*

❖ **Finalize Strategic Plan and Map: March-May 2007**

**Task 3: Technical Assistance to 10 projects: Throughout**

*Status—could use significant assistance with technical side of actually siting facilities here in the Valley—need an attorney to help with Clean Renewable Energy Bond program, could benefit from GIS experts and/or engineers to help with map development*
